Pathway to STHM Scholarship

2021 Application

Temple University's School of Sport, Tourism & Hospitality Management (STHM) selects one (1) incoming, domestic applicant from an underrepresented population demonstrating financial need who is looking to continue their education through a master's degree in the field of sport, tourism, or hospitality. This tuition scholarship will provide an underrepresented high-need student with access to graduate education. <u>The Pathway to STHM Scholarship Application</u> <u>deadline is June 30, 2021.</u>

Eligible applicants include:

- Students who have been admitted into either the MS in Sport Business, MS in Hospitality Management or MS in Travel and Tourism on or by June 30, 2021 for the Fall 2021 term.
- 2) U.S. Citizens at the time of application. International students are not eligible to complete the FAFSA and should refer to the "Financing Your Degree" section on the STHM website for scholarships applicable to International Students.
- Applicants who have at or above a 3.0 cumulative GPA at the completion of their undergraduate education.
- 4) Applicant from an underrepresented* population.

*This term includes students from groups who have been traditionally underrepresented in postsecondary education, such as racial/ethnic minorities, first-generation low-income (FGLI) college students, students with disabilities, students from lower socio-economic households, students in underrepresented industries (gender, ethnicity, and identity), marginalized identities and community college students.

5) Applicants who demonstrate a financial need (see instructions below on how to fill out a FAFSA application).

Steps to Apply:

- 1) Review eligibility requirements listed above. Only eligible applicants will be reviewed for selection.
- 2) In a separate Word or PDF document, answer the three (3) questions below. Selected candidates will be based on the quality and authenticity of their responses:
 - 1. How does your identity and/or representation impact your access in pursuing an advanced degree and/or graduate education?
 - 2. Describe what this award would personally mean to you and the importance of continuing your education at STHM.
 - 3. How will the attainment of an advanced degree assist with your personal contribution to the industry?

- Complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the upcoming academic semester by June 30, 2021. The FAFSA is available at: http://www.fafsa.ed.gov/
- 4) Complete and sign the form below. Email the completed form along with your answers to the questions above to sthmgrad@temple.edu on or by June 30, 2021.

Selected students will:

- 1) Be awarded a scholarship worth 75% of the cost of graduate tuition at STHM.
- 2) Be asked to complete an exit interview at the end of the graduate program.

Members of STHM's DEI committee will review submitted applicants (students on the committee will be recused from the selection process) and select (1) student to be awarded the scholarship. If there are no eligible applicants, the award will not be granted that academic year.
